Feast of Trumpets or New Year also known as (**Rosh HaShanah**) The Beginning of the Civil New Year; the Ten Days of Repentance that follow it, and Yom Kippur make up the High Holy Days. Jewish tradition says that God writes every person's words, deeds and thoughts in the Book of Life, which he opens and examines on this day. If good deeds outnumber sinful ones for the year, that person's name will be inscribed in the book for another year on Yom Kippur. So during Rosh HaShanah and the Ten Days of Repentance, people can repent of their sins and do good deeds to increase their chances of being inscribed in the Book of Life. **For the Church** The Feast of Trumpets will be fulfilled at the "Rapture" of the Church (I Thessalonians 4: 16 – 17) (I Corinthians 15: 52)

Day of Atonement: The Day the High Priest makes atonement for sin, also known as Day of Atonement, is the most solemn Holy Day of the Jewish people. Yom means "day" and Kippur means "atonement" or "covering". Atonement means the reconciliation of God and man. The ten days between Rosh HaShanah and Yom Kippur are known as the "days of repentance". **Yom Kippur** is the final day of judgment when God judges the people. The High Priest sacrificed an animal to pay for his sins and the sins of the people. (Hebrews 9: 6 – 8) When the High Priest was finished with the atonement sacrifice, a goat was released into the wilderness. This "scapegoat" carried Israel's sins away, never to return. (Leviticus 16: 8 -10, 20 – 22, 29 – 34) **Christ will fulfill the Day of Atonement** when he returns 7 years later after the "Rapture" at the end of the tribulation period. (Zachariah 12:10, 13:1, 12:6, 14:4)

Originally created as one of God's highest angels, possessing all angelic attributes, Satan (Adversary) led angels in a rebellion. He is described as the originator and chief practitioner of sin (I John 3:8), "that wicked one" (I John 5:18) a thief and destroyer (St John 10:10) a deceiver (Revelation 12:9), murderer and liar (St John 8:44), and the accuser of the brethren (Revelation 12:10).

Satan's subtle nature is reflected in the first temptation (Genesis 3:1) and in his titles "angel of light" (II Corinthians 11:14) and him that "deceiveth the whole world" (Revelation 12:9). His present day activities include opposing the will and work of God, counterfeiting the work of God, and destroying all that is good.

A Christian can overcome Satan when he remembers four basic principles: **First**, though Jesus is greater than the Devil (I John 4:4), a Christian must still have a healthy respect for the Enemy: even the archangel Michael did not confront Satan except in the name of the Lord (Jude 9), **Second**, a wise Christian will evaluate his life and avoid those situations where he is most likely to be tempted (I Thessalonians 5:22). **Third**, he should resist the Devil by submitting to God (James 4:7-10). **Finally**, the Christian should always be prepared by wearing the Whole Armor of God (Ephesians 6:12 – 17).

CHRIST IS THE FEASTS OF ISRAEL THE SEVEN FEASTS OF ISRAEL

The seven feasts or “holy convocations” listed in Leviticus 23rd Chapter find their typological fulfillment in Christ. The first four feasts are already fulfilled, and the latter three will be fulfilled at the coming of Christ:

- (1) *The Passover* speaks of our redemption, which was accomplished on the Cross (I Peter 1: 18 – 19) and is followed by...
- (2) *The Feasts of Unleavened Bread*, typical of our justification (II Corinthians 5: 21) and sanctification (I Corinthians 5: 7), also accomplished by Christ on the Cross.
- (3) *The Feasts of First Fruits* was fulfilled in the resurrection of Christ (I Corinthians 15: 20).
- (4) *Pentecost* was fulfilled when Christ sent the Holy Spirit to begin the harvest of the church (Acts 2: 1 - 41).
- (5) *The Feast of Trumpets* will be fulfilled at the rapture of the church (I Corinthians 15: 52; I Thessalonians 4: 16 – 17)
- (6) *The Day of Atonement* will be completed seven years later when Christ returns (Zechariah 12: 10; 13: 1) (Zechariah 12: 6; 14: 4)
- (7) *The Feast of Tabernacles* – Nehemiah 8: 14 -18 – will find its final fulfillment in Christ’s thousand – year kingdom on earth (Zechariah 14: 16)

All of the feasts include a Sabbath, reminding the Christians of their rest in Christ (St. Matthew 11: 28)
